

What does a medical transcriptionist do?

Each time a patient has an encounter with a healthcare provider, this is documented in the patient's medical record. In most cases, a physician dictates a report to be filed in the patient's medical record. The medical transcriptionist converts this dictation to written form for documentation.

The transcriptionist sits at a computer and transcribes medical reports with the aid of a foot pedal and headphones. Foot pedals allow a transcriptionist to fast forward, rewind, pause, speed up or slow down dictation.

This medical transcription is accredited by the Association for Healthcare Documentation Integrity, the authoritative body over medical transcription. The program upholds the highest standards to achieve this certification, ensuring quality education for every student.

National Certification Test

The Association for Healthcare Documentation and Integrity (AHDI) hosts two voluntary certification exams for medical transcriptionists. The Certified Medical Transcriptionist (CMT) exam requires that you have two years of transcription experience in acute care. The Registered Medical Transcription (RMT) exam can be taken after completion of a medical transcription education program. Certification is not required to become employed as a medical transcriptionist. Some employers are willing to pay a higher wage to transcriptionists who are certified.
