#### To submit tax information:

- **(Preferred Method)** Log back into your FAFSA and use the IRS data retrieval tool to link your taxes to your FAFSA. If you use this method make sure to resubmit the FAFSA so we receive the updated version.
- All Tax Returns must be signed by the tax payer
- Make sure to include any schedules that apply to your income
- If you no longer have a copy of your tax return you may order a Tax Return Transcript from the IRS online at <a href="www.irs.gov">www.irs.gov</a> or call 800-908-9946 to request a transcript and they will be mailed to you in 5-10 business days.
