

Construction Program Toolkit

Students in the Construction programs are required to have a toolkit for lab activities. This document provides a list of the minimum requirements. A toolkit may be purchased directly from the IWCC cashier. It is best to purchase it prior to the beginning of the semester to insure delivery in time for lab activities. If you currently own some tools of professional quality, you can purchase what you need to fill out your set. Sets must consist of professional grade tools and match the required minimum list.

- Tool kits will be kept in the program area and must not be removed until the student has completed the program. Program staff and the student will inspect their toolkit and contents when the student leaves the program.

The total cost of tools for this program is estimated to be approximately \$400. If you have financial aid and expect a refund this semester, you may be able to apply the refund toward the purchase of your toolkit. To see if you have a refund coming to you, contact your College Success Advisor.

Toolkit Minimum Requirements

- 5 Gallon Pail
- 6 in 1 Multi-Bit Screwdriver Set
- 8" Claw Nail Puller
- 9" Magnetic Torpedo Level
- 10" Straight-Cut Aviation Snips (yellow)
- 25' Tape Measure
- 100' Chalk Reel with Blue Chalk
- Beveled Chisel Set – 3-piece
 - ½ in Chisel
 - ¾ in Chisel
 - 1 in Chisel
- Carpentry Pencils (Qty: 3)
- Claw Hammer, Smooth Face
- Clear Safety Glasses
- Pliers Set - 2 Piece:
 - Large Slip-Joint Pliers
 - Side Cutters
- Retractable Blade Utility Knife
- Speed Square Kit
- Tool Belt with Framing Pouche(s) and Shoulder Straps
 - Tool Belt
 - Tool Belt Framing Pouche(s)
 - Tool Bel Shoulder Straps

*It is necessary that students in the Construction program wear **safety boots and jeans** for use during lab assignments and activities. The **safety boots and jeans** must be purchased on your own as they are not available through IWCC.*
