

IWCC Admission for Academic Track: Proving English Proficiency

To qualify for admission to an academic program of study, students must fulfill all the college's application and admission requirements, as well as provide one of the following forms of English language assessment for admission. Alternatively, students may provide documentation proving that they originate from or have completed education in one of the recognized Waiver Countries.

Secondary and Post-Secondary Achievement

These requirements will be met or waived only after Iowa Western has received and evaluated official documents, including transcripts.

- Previous completion of at least two years of high school (secondary) in the U.S. Official transcripts required. HiSET/GED Completion of Exams in English
- Previous completion of college Level English: Grade of 'C' or higher in college level English composition course at a regionally accredited U.S. college or university. Official transcripts required.
- Earned an Associate, Bachelor, Master, or Doctorate Degree at a regionally accredited U.S. college or university. Official transcript required.
- Earned 30 or more semester credits of college level (not ESL) coursework at a regionally accredited U.S. college or university. Official transcript required.
- Successful completion of the Iowa Western ESL program and/or Pathway program with a grade of 'C' or higher.

Proof of completion of ESL study with grades of 'C' or higher at one of the following approved intensive English Language Schools. Other programs may be considered upon request.

- Creighton University IELI completion of level **High Intermediate**
- Metropolitan Community College ESL completion of **ESLX 0835 Academic Reading and Writing 5**
- Iowa State University completion of **ENGL 101C English for Native Speakers of Other Languages: Academic English II**
- ELS completion of **English for Academic Purposes Level 109**
