

Iowa Western does not offer a fulltime intensive English language program. It offers a short-term, one semester Pathway program intended to introduce students to introductory undergraduate classes. Students will be eligible to earn 6 academic credits while polishing vital skills needed for success at Iowa Western. Students are required to be pursuing a Certificate, a Diploma, or an Associate's Degree.

To qualify for admission to Iowa Western's Pathway program, students must fulfill all of the application and admission requirements of Iowa Western's programs, as well as, provide one of the following forms of English language assessment for admission. If you are in progress of meeting one of Iowa Western's English proficiency requirements you may apply to receive conditional admission into academic programs at Iowa Western.
