

Paraeducator Generalist

The course is a 90-hour program developed to train individuals to work under the supervision of teachers or other licensed personnel in the classroom setting. Convenient classes to fit a busy schedule. Our program meets the Iowa Board of Educational Examiners requirements. The program is offered as a hybrid course with Zoom sessions and online work.

Substitute Authorization

If you have a Bachelors, Associates, or Paraprofessional Educator's license YOU can become a substitute teacher. Choose from several start dates. Iowa Western offers the Board of Educational Examiner's approved Substitute Authorization course, which allows an individual to substitute in a K-12 institution for no more than five consecutive days in one job assignment. All students must arrange and complete two classroom observations with the school of their choice.






EMERGENCY SERVICES (EMS)

Use your skills to treat acute illnesses and work in traumatic situations alongside firefighters and other medical personnel. Save lives.



This course emphasizes the development of student skills in a patient assessment-based program, recognition of signs and symptoms regarding illness or injury, and the proper procedures when rendering emergency care to the sick or injured.

Advanced Emergency Medical Technician AEMT

The primary focus is the basic and limited advanced emergency medical care and transportation for critical and emergent patients who access the emergency medical system.



(%) Emergency Medical Responder EMR

EMRs are often the first to arrive on scene. They must quickly assess patient needs, initiate treatment, and request additional resources.



Paramedics provide the highest level of pre-hospital emergency care. The standards prepare the EMT and AEMT for the more advanced scope of practice of the paramedic.

(Critical Care Paramedic

The course covers the lowa scope of practice and will lead to eligibility to obtain a Critical Care endorsement on an Iowa Paramedic license.

RITA started teaching American Heart Association CPR and First Aid at Iowa Western in 1993. Rita said it's very important everyone knows CPR because you never know when someone might need it. Rita uses CPR feedback devices to improve the student resuscitation technique. She teaches various classes on campus, at local companies and schools. Working with friendly people is why she works for Continuing Education. Rita Pierson, Training Center Faculty, is making a difference for IWCC and the community!

CPR & First Aid

American Heart Association

Pediatric First Aid and CPR/AED courses fulfill the needs and requirements for a Child Care Provider or Foster Parent.

CPR/AED for Adult-Child-Infant

courses are for individuals who are not healthcare providers and meets the needs for employers, coaches, law enforcement and family members.

BLS Provider course is required for EMS providers, nurses, firefighters, other healthcare professionals, and for students in a healthcare program.

BLS New Instructor course requires you have a current AHA BLS provider certification and be proficient in skills of CPR/AED.

CPR Instructor Renewal course is required to continue teaching. You must have a current BLS with minimum of 4 classes taught in 2 year renewal period.



High School Driver Education Learning to drive is a major milestone

in a teenager's life. The lowa Western class includes 30 hours of classroom instruction and 6 hours of behind the wheel driving. The instructor is highly qualified with 10+ years of drivers education experience. During the school year, classes start in February and September and meet on Saturdays. The summer June and July classes meet Monday-Friday for 2 weeks. An informative parent meeting is scheduled before the student's first day of class, to ensure all questions and concerns are addressed.

Moped Safety

It's essential that beginning moped riders learn and use the proper techniques and safe practices. This course is required for anyone under 16 wanting a moped license. Moped Safety satisfies the Iowa Department of Transportation requirement for riders under age 16. Instruction is classroom only.

Motorcycle Safety
