### 260 F Program Overview

#### Funding to train your current employees

Iowa Jobs Training Program provides forgivable loans to Iowa businesses to train existing workers. The purpose of the program is to help Iowa businesses stretch their training dollars to strengthen the skills and productivity of their team.

#### WHAT TYPES OF BUSINESSES ARE ELIGIBLE?

Businesses in lowa that are engaged in manufacturing, processing, warehousing, distributing, and wholesaling.

#### WHAT TRAINING COSTS CAN BE REIMBURSED?

Eligible training can include Industrial Maintenance; Computer Skills; Health and Safety; Management and Supervision; Language and Communication; and much more.

#### WHO CONDUCTS THE TRAINING?

Traning may be provided by:

- IWCC provides contracted training services to businesses on-site or on-campus, customized to fit your unique training needs.
- Contract Training coordinated through business by an outside service provider.

#### **HOW MUCH FUNDING ARE WE ELIGIBEL FOR?**

Businesses may receive up to \$100,000 in funds every three calendar years, depending on eligible training and availability of funds. Applications are competitively scored and compete for limited annual funding.

Funds are typically provided at an approximate 60/40 cash match (260F funds/Company match)
