LEARNING SERVICES

HISET ACADEMY (FORMERLY KNOWN AS GED)

lowa Western offers preparation courses and exam opportunities for adults to take the High School Equivalency Test (HiSET), formerly known as the GED. The High School Equivalency Diploma (HSED) is equivalent to a high school diploma. Our staff will be with you every step of the way and will provide guidance and support. Choose a location and class schedule that fits your needs.

HISET PREPERATION

For those who have not completed their high school education, instruction is available in preparing for the five HiSET tests: Language Arts-Writing, Language Arts-Reading, Social Studies, Science, and Mathematics. You may prepare for the exams by attending classes at one of our sites. Studying online through Essential Education's HiSET Academy is an online option. BASIC SKILLS TRAINING
