

**If you have a REAL ID (ID with a gold star), a U.S. passport, or a Green Card, that will count as both your identity document and your eligibility document.**

Identity document: any photo ID that has your name and picture on it.

Eligibility document:

U.S. Citizen	U.S. birth certificate <i>or</i> U.S. passport <i>or</i> naturalization certificate
U.S. National (born in U.S. territories, such as American Samoa, Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands, Puerto Rico, or the U.S. Virgin Islands)	Passport <i>or</i> birth certificate
Lawful Permanent Resident	Green Card (Form I-551)
Refugee	I-94 with code “RE” <i>or</i> USCIC approval notice
Asylee	I-94 with code “AS” <i>or</i> asylum grant letter
Parolee (1+ year)	I-94 marked “Parole” valid for greater than or equal to one year
Cuban or Haitian Entrant	I-94 or USCIS notice
Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) Self-Petitioner or battered alien	USCIS letter of approval or prima facie determination
